

They will receive a **\$5000 scholar-ship voucher** to use for post-secondary tuition. To apply to be considered as Royal Bay's nominee, please put together the following application package:

- A scholarship resume (emphasizing your school & community service, volunteer experience, academic successes, etc.)
- **Two reference letters**, one from a community member/ organization *and* one from your school or a teacher
- A written statement, *maximum* 500 words, in which you describe:
- What led you to your most relevant community service, volunteer activity, and/or leadership role;
- What you learned from this experience;

How this experience will benefit you in your chosen career path.

Submit your completed application package to Mrs. Glanfield in the Counseling Suite by **3:30 pm** on **February 1st**. The Scholarship Committee will meet to select the RBSS nominee, then forward his/her application to compete at the District level.
