## **myBlueprint LOGGING In**

**Please read through ALL of the information below about how to log into myBlueprint.**

If you have followed these steps, and you are still unable to access myBlueprint, please see Ms. ten Hove in Room 2105B during A or B Blocks.

### **1) Consent:**

a. Ensure that your parents have provided consent. You do not have consent if you see the following when you try to log in: "PEN does not match" or spinning wheel.

b. The link to the 'Consent' portal: <https://consent.sd62.bc.ca/apps/OnlineConsent>

### **2) Logging in:**

a. Go to the link attached (use Google/Google Chrome): <https://app.myblueprint.ca/?sdid=sd62>

b. Select "School Account Log in" - in the **green bar**, middle of the screen page.

c. This will take you to the Sooke Potholes picture and single sign on.

Use your wifi log in credentials, and if you have consent, you are in. --->Your wifi login and password are what you use when you access the school wifi on your phone. It should be your first name initial and your last name initial, plus four digits from your student number (ex. Jacqui tenHove: jt5564).

b. You should not need a PEN number to sign up. If you do, it may be because you don't have parent consent. See point #1 above.
