As we return to in-class support, hearing from you is important.

The Ministry of Education has announced a partial return to in-class support beginning June 1st. As you may know, returning to in-class support is **part-time** and **voluntary** (not mandatory). Teachers will continue to provide and support the continuity of learning plans and learning opportunities through remote (online) learning and other instructional means.

For middle & secondary students, the purpose of a return to school in June is to further support remote learning in academic subjects with a focus on course completion and meeting academic requirements for graduation that cannot be completed remotely. Support for experiential courses will be offered however, due to Health & Safety protocols experiential opportunities that involve 'hands on' learning such as art, wood, metal, automotive, foods, culinary arts, home economics, cosmetology, PHE, music, electronics, computer & science labs will not be available. Students will come to the school via a registration process and by appointment only.

Dear RBSS Grade 12 Students and Families,

We are excited with the recent announcements from the Premier and Public Health Officer that have allowed us to offer an in-person Commencement Ceremony for our graduates in addition to the planned video celebration. As stated by Superintendent Scott Stinson, there will be an opportunity for small groups of students (groups of 30) to walk across the Royal Bay Teechamitsa Theatre stage as we do our best to recognize our graduates. This event will take place on between Monday, June 22 through Thursday, June 25 during the day between 10am & 4pm.

As outlined by our Superintendent, students will come to the school in small groups to cross the stage, receive their graduation folder, and take a professional photo. Youth Verses is a series of three cost-free workshops for youth (ages 14-19) who identify as artists over the platform Zoom. The intent of these workshops is to have conversations about ways to be creative while struggling with mental health by providing a collaborative and safe space where youth are supported and inspired to create visual and/or performance art to be displayed in a virtual showcase.

These workshops will be hosted by Neko Smart, Victoria's eighth Youth Poet Laureate. As Youth Poet Laureate, her goal is to open up conversation about mental health to reduce stigma and increase safety, particularly for youth. Neko Smart is a graduate of Victoria High School, and the founder and past captain of the Vic High Slam Poetry Team. She encourages vulnerability in writing as a way of healing through written word.
