4. REPORTS:

SPEAC:

- Paula reported that the Emergency Preparation Committee will have a meeting on March 11.
- Healthy Schools will have a meeting on April 20.
- The Constitution and Bi-Law committee have reviewed all the bi-laws.
- The next SPEAC meeting will be on March 17 during Spring Break.

• Principal's Report:

- It has been a long February. Staff and students are looking forward to the March break.
- The French Immersion program geared for RBSS will be reviewing the catchment boundaries. The administration had an information night for the junior high parent group slated for this program. This was a meeting that was needed to answer any questions parents had about the program. One hundred students will be coming in September. By 2024, the student population for RBSS will increase to 1500-1600 students.
- The course selections have been completed. The counselors have gone into the classrooms to assist students with selections.
- The Jack talks on Feb 23 were well received. Some students personally thanked the admin for having this happen. There was an uptake on information available from the office.
- University of Victoria will be having some virtual nights for students and parents.
- For the Post-Secondary applications, there are many scholarships which have not been applied for. We are trying to encourage students to apply.
- Mosaic of Kindness- project sponsored by the leadership group. Kids write inspiring messages and post in the hallways. It has been very successful.
- The administration has been trying to do little things for the graduates.
- While sports can practice, there is no contact allowed. It is very limiting but that how it has to be right now.
- The TASK program continues. They are putting a shed into our new garden at the back of the school. Eventually a fence will be installed.
- Grade 10/12 Assessments will be in mid-April.
- The next Octa 6 begins on March 8th.
- Looks like the school will be going to the ¼ system in September as long as full days will be reinstated.
- The grade 12s have been resigned to no special events this year. A
 number of students are now completed their required courses for the
 year. Lots of students have employment. Our course completion rate is
 98% and grades have increased by 10 % on average. The teachers have
 started a working group on how to support our grade twelves during this
 time. They are looking at grad appreciation days.
