All students are enrolled in a Career Education course at Royal Bay Secondary. Here is what it will look like at each grade level.

Careers 9 - Teacher lead: Amanda Cheeseman

Amanda will visit grade 9 classes this month to assist students with myBlueprint login and assignment completion. Additionally, Careers 9 will be paired with math, science, social studies and English this year.

Career Life Education 10 – Teacher leads: Adrian Mathieu (semester 1), Megan Wood (semester 2)

Adrian and Megan will work with students to deliver the curriculum during student's social studies 10 class. Additionally, students will be working through tasks in myBlueprint to meet the course requirements.

Career Life Connections 11 – Teacher lead: Leanne Harrington, supporting teachers Danielle Huculak in semester 1 and Megan Wood in semester 2

Leanne, Danielle and Megan will work with students during their English 11 class to begin work on the Capstone Project.

Career Life Connections 12 - Teacher lead: Danielle Huculak

Grads will select an in-school mentor who they will meet with informally during the year to support them on their planning for post-graduation. Danielle will visit grade 12 classes throughout the year to conduct discussions with grads and support them with their Capstone Project completion. All grads will present their Capstone Projects to their in-school mentor on May 4th during our first school-wide Capstone Presentation Day.


- X country (parent already in staff to help? Or another parent to support?)
