# From the Admin.

Dear RBSS Families,

As we ease into June, I am sure the excitement of the yearbook arrival is upon you. It is with this anticipation that we wanted to reach out ahead of time, to give you a better awareness of delivery expectations.

Our yearbook distributor has sent us some discouraging news. It seems that although the Royal Bay Yearbook class had the yearbook complete and sent in well ahead of time (pre-March Break), the books are held up in shipping. The current estimated arrival to port is mid to late June. This vessel was originally due to arrive almost two weeks earlier, but, like the majority of local and international shipments, was faced with port delays and congestion along the way. We are hoping that the books arrive at Royal Bay on June  $24^{th}$ , so that we can deliver them to our students on June  $27^{th} - 29^{th}$ . Please note that this delay in delivery is affecting numerous schools around the area and province.

Although out of our control, we are truly sorry that you are experiencing a late and difficult delivery, despite submitting our final pages and approval on time. We are working with the yearbook company and are continuing to do all we can to get the books to our students as quickly as possible. Once the vessel arrives in port, the yearbook company is working with their partners to ensure a quick turnaround. It is possible that the vessel unloads seamlessly, and that we may be able to have the books on hand to deliver to our students by June 27<sup>th</sup>.

If we do not get the delivery in time we will make the books available when they arrive. To our grade 12 students, we will make sure that these yearbooks are available to you either for pick up or through mail delivery.

This is not the outcome we were expecting, and I am sorry for the disappointment it will cause, especially for those students who worked so hard to get the yearbook done.

Hoping for delivery on the 24<sup>th</sup> of June. We will make sure to send another email alerting families when the yearbooks are ready for pickup.




