#### Principal's Report:

- VP Mark Johnston is moving to district office as VP Inclusive Education
  - Sad to see him go
- New VP Ryan Dube from Belmont starts on Feb. 6
  - Really strong and looking forward to his impact on the school
- French Immersion teachers
  - Very difficult to hire qualified teachers
  - Growth in the schools it's been difficult, nearly impossible to hire new teachers
  - Hired 2 new teachers to handle Sciences 10, FRAL 9, Sciences Humaines 9
    - Teachers hired who aren't fluent in French, but are capable of speaking French
  - Other options would have been to fold the classes and make them English
  - Trying their best to get teachers
- Black history month
  - Workshops and other activities planned
  - Each department will be working on different activities
- Assessment week and semester turnaround week
  - Literacy and Numeracy 10 and 12 exams happened
  - Advocating strongly for a week where kids aren't being pulled from their classrooms to do these assessments and can just have time to focus on the assessments and not

class work too (similar to how it was 20 yrs ago when provincial exams were still a thing)

- Grad capstone projects completed last week
  - All did a great job
  - CLC program (careers life course) went well with how it was structured into the Grade 12 timetable. Will be doing this again next year
- Grad ski trip next weekend
  - 50 students attending
- Cell phone expectations
  - Working with committee of students/staff at school to have cell phone hotels
  - So far going ok
  - If parents need to contact student during the day, it's best to contact office to reach out
- New mountain biking academy coming to RBSS
- Bones of Crows movie based on residential schools
  - Being shown at theater on Feb. 4 to general public
  - Feb. 14 being shown at school to students
- Grade 8 parent night tomorrow night
  - Expecting full house
  - Kids from Stubbs and Dunsmuir came to visit already
  - Bringing the students back to watch part of the theater production
- Course selection happening now
- School is growing
  - 2 portables coming soon
- Working with a person at Avignon, France to create an exchange program with students
  - 5 week exchange being planned
  - Free exchange program but need to pay airfare
  - Working on figuring out credits while attending the school in France
- Spring Fling committee formed to plan a dance for Grade 9 and 10 students in the spring
- Bringing in lifeguarding course to give the kids a bronze medallion/bronze cross certification
- Working on replacing the soft furniture that was all ruined by the Percep disinfectant during COVID
- New reporting piece from ministry about self-assessments for high school students
  - Working on how to get every student to do this for each of their courses
  - Difficult task with so many students
