#### Student MyEdBC Portal Setup:

In our ongoing commitment to enhancing the educational experience for our students, the admin team and careers department have been visiting all Grade 9 classes supporting students with setting up their Student MyEdBC Portal accounts. This portal is a valuable platform that will enable your child to access report cards, make course selections, see their graduation status and review graduation assessment results.

#### Take Your Student To Work Day (November 1, 2023):

We are also excited to announce our participation in the "Take Your Student To Work Day" program, scheduled for November 1, 2023. This initiative provides an excellent opportunity for students to gain insights into various careers and workplaces. Students will have the chance to observe professionals in action and learn about potential career paths they may be interested in pursuing.

#### **Consent Forms:**

# Reminder to Parents the Parking Expectation:

As you may be aware, two portables have been installed in the staff parking lot. This has resulted in the loss of a number of staff parking stalls and one of the exits to this lot. With over 150 staff members and only 130 parking stalls available, we encourage all members of our school community to consider alternative transportation options, such as walking, taking public transport, or cycling to school whenever possible.

To address the after-school traffic congestion, we kindly request your cooperation in considering the following suggestions:

- 1. **Choosing Alternative Meeting Spots:** We ask that you make arrangements with your student(s) for a meeting spot other than the staff lots and the front of the school. Please note that parents are NOT permitted to park in staff lots.
- 2. Arriving at 3:30 PM Mon-Thur, 2:30 PM Fri: If you are picking up your students after school, we suggest arriving 10 minutes after the bell to allow time for the majority of students to clear the building and use the crosswalk. This will help alleviate congestion during the peak dismissal period. We understand that time may vary for each family, but arriving a bit later can significantly ease the traffic situation.
- 3. NO Idle Zone: While waiting for your student, turn your vehicle off.






