The staff at ÉRBSS would like to extend a huge thank you to you all for your support throughout the first week as we got the school up and running. It is awesome to see the excitement and joy of our students as they start the school year. Thursday, September 5 was photo day, it was a great success, and the students looked great! Cell Phone Expectations

Last year RBSS put into practice school wide cell phone expectations. The students responded wonderfully. Again, this year we have the same expectations in place, back by provincial decree.

Students may use personal mobile devices during instructional time for educational purposes as directed by the teacher, for health or medical purposes or as assistive technology for the purpose of inclusive education as informed by the Inclusive Education Teacher. At all other times, personal cell phones shall remain "off and away" for the duration of the school day.

This policy applies to ear buds/headphones as well.

École Royal Bay Secondary School recognizes the importance of communication, collaboration, and digital citizenship. To keep the focus on learning and to reduce unnecessary distractions, the school will expect the following:

- Unless requested by a teacher, as per above, cell phones and other mobile devices shall be TURNED OFF and stored in your locker or on your person (out of sight) from 8:55 am until the final bell at the end of the day.
- Cell phones and all mobile devices are not allowed to be used in the school, unless directed by a teacher and can only be used for the purposes of learning.
- Cell phones and all mobile devices can be turned back on at the end of the school day and used to communicate directly with parents/friends who are assisting in transportation
- If a student needs to make an emergency call during the day, they are to come to the office as a
 phone is provided for such a purpose.
- Should a parent need to contact their child urgently, please call the office and we will facilitate this
 communication.




