As an integral part of the Provincial Health Education Curriculum, ÉRBSS is looking forward to welcoming Mia Golden and Gord McGee from the Mobile Youth Service Team (MYST). MYST has been identified as the most important "Prevention and Intervention" team in Greater Victoria that focuses on Youth Exploitation.

Mia Golden has been a Youth and Family Counsellor for over 30 years and is the backbone of MYST. Her current partner is Cst. Gord Magee, bringing 26 years of policing experience to the team. On Monday and Tuesday Feb 10th & 11th, Mia and Gord will be presenting a 60-minute workshop covering the following topics: Consent, Exploitation, The Impact of Pornography on the Brain, Online Safety, in addition to Safety Strategies and Resources for our students.

We feel fortunate to welcome Mia and Gord to facilitate these workshops. Our school counsellors will be available, after the sessions, should students need access to additional supports.

The assemblies will focus on our grade 9's during A Block and grade 10's B Block Monday and Tuesday.

Grade 11 & 12 Immunizations!



School Newsletter Grade 11 & 12

Public Health will be providing an opportunity for grade 11 and 12 students who remain eligible for childhood & school-age immunizations (excluding COVID-19 and influenza vaccines) to be immunized at an upcoming school-based immunization clinic. Certain vaccines are not publicly funded after the age of 18. A letter with more information will be sent home with Grade 11 and 12 students shortly.

B.C. has launched a Cancer Care Action Plan to better prevent, detect, and treat cancers. As part of the prevention strategy, Island Health students in grade 11 and 12 will be offered an additional opportunity to catch up on HPV vaccination, a safe and effective way to prevent a variety of cancers.

Please discuss the information in this letter with your child, as students in grade 11 and 12 will be offered the opportunity to consent to or refuse immunizations on their own behalf through the mature minor consent process. Children under the age of 19, who can understand the benefits of getting immunized, possible side effects after receiving the immunization, and the risk of not getting immunized, can legally consent to getting the immunization or refuse it.


The school-based immunization clinic will be held February 19th and 20th at Royal Bay Secondary.
