Wellness Centre

RBSS is fortunate to have a wellness centre on site run by VIHA (Vancouver Island Health Authority). A Wellness Centre is a centralized location where students will find a number of health services for mental, sexual, and physical health, as well as health promotion strategies. It is a place where students can be assessed, treated, and referred to other programs or services as needed. School Hours

Students need to plan to be at school by 8:55am and leave school by 4pm (3:00 on Fridays) unless they are scheduled into an after-school class or activity with a Teacher or Community Coach. Students who have activities later in the evening need to go home between the end of school and the start of their activity as we do not have supervision on site for extended wait times.

Attendance

Regular and punctual attendance is a vital part of student success. Students must arrange their transport schedules to arrive at school on time and remain at school until classes finish. Any absences must be called in to the school: 250-474-2377 or notified by email: royalbay@sd62.bc.ca.

Student employment can be an important part of a young person's learning and growth. However, after-school jobs need to be balanced with schoolwork. Students should ensure that they are scheduling work shifts well after the school day has ended. Students interested in gaining credits for work experience and making this part of their educational program are encouraged to visit their Counsellor and the Career Centre.

School Supplies

There is no need to shop for school supplies over the summer. Students should bring a binder, paper, and pens to the first day of classes. Teachers will let students know if they need additional supplies.

Lockers

Lockers will be made available via an app starting in September. Detailed instructions will be provided once students are in session.

Student Parking

We ask students to walk, bike, or take a school or city bus to school. Students who choose to drive will need to park in the parking the lot across the track field. Students are not to remain parked in the drop off area in front of the school.

Fees

School fees can be paid through the <u>KEV School Cash System</u>. The Sooke School District 2025/2026 fee schedule can be found here.

- After consenting to School Cash Online, wait 24 hrs. before logging in and attaching your children.
- Create account login/password by choosing "Get Started Today".
- Students are encouraged to create an account as well.
- You will need to know the student's PEN number (on the report card) to complete this process.

Personal Devices

As per our code of conduct, Teachers may plan for student use of personal mobile devices for instructional purposes or digital literacy, for health or medical purposes or as assistive technology for the purpose of inclusive education as informed by the Inclusive Education Teacher. At all other times, personal mobile devices, inclusive of laptops and chrome books shall remain stored away for the duration of the school day (with the exception of lunchtime and transition times). This policy applies to ear buds/headphones as well.

Students will be asked to place their cell phones in a cell phone holder as they enter a classroom or leave their cell phones in their backpacks or locker. Families needing to urgently contact their child can contact the office at 250-474-2377.



Resolving Concerns

As a general guideline, communication should remain as close to the 'source' as possible. For example, if the topic pertains to something within the classroom, speak to the classroom teacher.
