<p>Future Grade 10s</p> <p>All Gr 10 students enroll in a minimum of nine (9) courses:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Four (4) are preloaded Required Courses;• Two (2) remaining Required Courses are selected respectively from English and Math options; and• Three (3) are Elective Requests:<ul style="list-style-type: none">◦ To meet Graduation Requirements, one (1) of these elective requests must be either an:<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ Applied Design, Skills and Technologies (ADST) elective; or▪ Arts Education elective <p>Students must also complete an Indigenous focused course in either Grades 10, 11 or 12.</p> <p>Students also select two (2) Alternate Requests in case one or more of their elective requests are full.</p> <p>Requests for courses beyond a student's grade level will be based on availability and space. Such accommodations need to be discussed with your school counsellor.</p> <hr/> <p>Course Request Breakdown:</p> <p>Required Courses:</p> <p>Grade 10 students are preloaded into the following four (4) required courses:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Career Life Education 10• Science 10• Social Studies 10• Physical and Health Education <p>Students must choose one Required Course option from each of the following:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• English 10:<ul style="list-style-type: none">◦ Option A: College Prep English 10: Composition & Spoken Language 10◦ Option B: Composition & New Media 10◦ Option C: Creative Writing & Spoken Language 10◦ Option D: English First Peoples 10: Spoken Language & New Media 10• Mathematics 10:<ul style="list-style-type: none">◦ Foundations of Mathematics & Pre-Calculus 10◦ Workplace Mathematics 10 <p>Elective Requests:</p> <p>Students must request three (3).</p> <p>To meet Graduation Requirements, one (1) of these elective requests must be either an:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Applied Design, Skills and Technologies (ADST) elective; or• Arts Education elective <p>Elective Requests (PHE):</p> <p>Students are limited to a maximum of one (1) PHE 10 elective request.</p> <p>Elective Requests (HUB):</p> <p>HUB electives are scheduled during the school day and students attend classes in the HUB portable. Teachers are available to support this online learning during this in-person class.</p> <p>Elective Requests (Online):</p> <p>SD62 Online Learning electives are in addition to regularly scheduled courses. Students complete course work completely online during their own time. Teachers are available to support this online learning during scheduled meetings pre-arranged between the student and the teacher.</p> <p>Alternate Requests:</p> <p>Students must request two (2).</p>

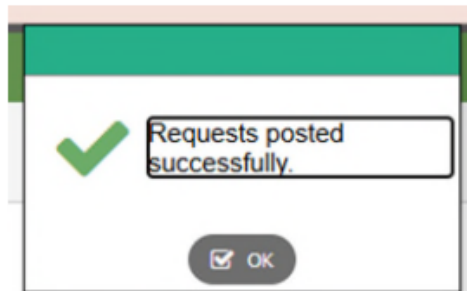
