Dear École Royal Bay Families and Students,

The information below will help with a successful end to this school year and start for the next one!

Tuesday, June 23rd will be our last day of regular instruction at Royal Bay for the 2025/26 school year. **June 24th and 25th** are course completion/extension days. These days are set aside for catching up on incomplete work to meet the learning outcomes of a course or to engage in deeper learning. Teachers may ask students to attend if they feel a student would benefit from additional learning time to show their understanding and meet course expectations. It is not reasonable for students to expect to hand in a full course load of work during this time. Students can pre-arrange appointments with their teachers to attend school on the course completion days. Report cards are published on MyEd on **June 25th**.

Our beautiful yearbooks will be distributed in the Learning Commons starting the morning of June 22nd and concluding on June 23rd. Please pick up before or after classes and make sure that all materials borrowed from Royal Bay (jerseys, books, technology, etc.) are returned to school before the summer.

The school year begins on **Tuesday, September 8, 2026** (Grade 9s only) from 9:00am – 11:50am and on **Wednesday, September 9, 2026** (all students) for a full day.

Families will receive additional details about the new school year, including access to schedules, in late August. Please note that student schedules were developed from their requests, and most classes are full. Course changes are not possible unless a student has an incomplete schedule (fewer than 8 in timetable classes), a student is missing a course required for graduation, or a change is required to balance class sizes. Counsellors will not be available over the summer but will meet with Gr 12 students, by appointment only, from September 1-3rd.
